Naperville Writers Group Literary Series Continues **With Reading by Beth Staas**

Personal honors and awards include Who's Who Among American Teachers, Tutor of the Year at Waubensee Community College, and cash awards from Associated Authors of Children's Literature, Houston.

In addition to Beth, other members of the Naperville Writers Group will read their prose and poetry, and time will be provided for members of the public to read during open mike.

The event will be held on Friday, October 26th from 7 to 9 pm at the Barnes and Noble at the Promenade Center in Bolingbrook, 631 E Boughton Road. The public is invited and the event is free. If you would like to read, please arrive early and sign up.

Future Naperville Writers Group events will be held once a month at the Bolingbrook Barnes and Noble. These readings will feature Naperville Writers Group members and other local authors. Each evening will provide open mike time for members of the public to read.
