Naperville Writers Group Continues 2009 Literary Series With Readings by Rabbi Mikki Mendelsohn

April 24, 7 to 9 pm at Barnes and Noble in Bolingbrook

Naperville, IL – The Naperville Writers Group’s April literary evening will feature poet, novelist and memoirist Mikki Mendelsohn.

Mendelsohn is a Rabbi, attorney, and college lecturer. She has sung in Off-Broadway shows and served the Israeli Defense Forces in the Entertainment Corps. She has published articles in various print and online magazines and has written a novel, a book of poems and is currently working on her memoir, *Rabbi, Your Cleavage is Showing*. “I believe that even at the saddest times,” Mendelsohn says, “we must force ourselves to look for some humor. It is the Jewish way.”

In addition to Mendelsohn, members of the Naperville Writers Group will read their prose and poetry, and time will be provided for members of the public to read during open mic.
