Naperville Writers Group Continues 2009 Literary Series With Readings by Sachin Waikar

Naperville, IL – The Naperville Writers Group’s June literary evening will feature Sachin Waikar.

Waikar’s award-winning writing appears or is forthcoming in national magazines and journals including *Esquire*, *Highlights*, *Kahani*, *Parents*, *South Asian Review*, and several published anthologies. His screenwriting has placed in HBO/Miramax’s Project Greenlight and been nominated for an ABC/Disney Talent Grant. Sachin is also a freelance writer/editor for Harvard Business School and Kellogg School of Management professors and multiple private companies.

Before turning to writing, Waikar worked as a business strategy consultant for McKinsey and Company and a Beverly Hills psychologist. A member of Phi Beta Kappa, he earned a B.A. in psychology with honors and distinction from Stanford University and a Ph.D. in clinical psychology from UCLA.

In addition to Waikar, members of the Naperville Writers Group will read their prose and poetry, and time will be provided for members of the public to read during open mic.

The event will be held on Friday, June 26th, from 7 to 9 pm at the Barnes and Noble at the Promenade Center in Bolingbrook, 631 E Boughton Road. The event is free and open to the public. If you would like to read, please arrive early and sign up.

Future Naperville Writers Group events will continue monthly at the Bolingbrook Barnes and Noble. These readings will feature Naperville Writers Group members and other local authors. Each evening will provide open mic time for members of the public to read.
